“A TASTE OF KANGAROO ISLAND”  
NOVEMBER 1-4, 2008**

**Saturday November 1st**

Refuel and lunch at Goolwa (YGWA). On to Kingscote (YKSC). Bus transfer to motel followed by a short tour of this historic town.

**Sunday November 2<sup>nd</sup>**

**Island Beehive**

Enjoy a guided tour, including a free honey tasting. Watch bees at work in the glass hive.

**Emu Ridge Eucalyptus Oil Distillery**

Learn the distilling process, operating the way it began in the 1890's.

**Kaiwarra Food Barn**

Enjoy a light lunch at the Kaiwarra Food Barn.

**Seal Bay**

One of only two places in the world where you can stroll with your guide through a wild seal colony. Seal Bay is home to around 600 of the rare Australian Sea Lions.

**The Island Pure Sheep Dairy**

See the sheep being milked and taste cheeses and yoghurt made at the dairy.

**Monday November 3<sup>rd</sup>**

**Flinders Chase National Park**

Visit the Flinders Chase Visitor Centre. Then travel through the park, enjoying breathtaking views of Yacca Flat and coastal scenery on your way to spectacular Remarkable Rocks. Take a walk around these huge rocks, which have been carved into many different weird and wonderful shapes by the wind and the ocean spray over many centuries.

Drive past the ruins of an early settlement at Weirs Cove before going on to the Cape du Couedic Lighthouse built in 1906, and the natural land bridge that is "Admirals Arch". Look out for the New Zealand Fur Seals frolicking in the water and on the rocks under the arch.

**Western KI Caravan Park (Lunch) & Koala Walk**

A two-course BBQ lunch will be provided. Then wander among the nearby gum trees to see koalas taking their afternoon siesta.

**Andermel Marron Farm**

View marron in holding tanks and discover the life of marron and how and where they are exported to. Also enjoy a wine tasting of some of Kangaroo Islands' fine wines.

**Tuesday November 4<sup>th</sup>**

Bus transfer to Kingscote airport

**Don't Want To Fly?** Drive to Victor Harbor and take the Cape Jervis Ferry (pre-book on [www.sealink.com.au](http://www.sealink.com.au)) or take a commercial flight from Adelaide to Kingscote.

**Costs:** 3 nights accommodation, all meals, tours and airport transfers for \$470/head (twin share) or \$410/head (triple share).

Tour is limited to a maximum of 21 people. RVAC members have first preference secured by a non-refundable deposit of \$220/head (twin share) or \$165/head (triple share). Places on the tour will be allocated in order of receipt of deposit monies.

After March 31<sup>st</sup> the tour will be offered to members at Yarra Valley, Cobden & Goolwa clubs, friends and relatives.
